## About the College

Government College Barwala Panchkula established on 31st July, 1993 stands as one of the oldest colleges in Panchkula and its nearby districts. It is situated in the rural area of village Barwala. The institution prides itself on fostering self-discipline and a strong work ethic among its students. With a vision to become a premier institution of higher learning, it is dedicated to providing quality education to rural students while instilling values of social responsibility, academic excellence, and open-mindedness. Committed to offering opportunities for skill development, the college aims to equip students to become competent, self-reliant, and socially conscious individuals.

## Introduction

Spread across 9 acres of picturesque land, our college offers a serene and inspiring environment for learning. The sprawling campus is adorned with lush fruit trees, vibrant flowers, and a tranquil Herbal Park, creating a refreshing atmosphere for students. Since its establishment in 1993, the college has been a beacon of education, serving not only the urban and rural areas of Panchkula but also the adjoining towns of Punjab. Affiliated with Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, the college offers a total six diverse range of academic programs, five undergraduate courses: Bachelor of Arts (B.A.), Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.), Bachelor of Commerce (Honors), Bachelor of Computer Applications (B.C.A.), and Bachelor of Physical Science, along with one postgraduate course, M.Sc. in Geography. With a commitment to academic excellence and holistic development, the college continues to empower students with knowledge and skills for a brighter future.

## Student Strength

In the current session (2024-25), the college has a total of 380 students, with 186 girls and 194 boys. With the dedicated efforts of the faculty, our students



continuously bring laurels to the college in both academics and extracurricular activities.

Under the guidance of Ms. Seema Grewal and her committee, Incubation centre nurtures entrepreneurial spirit and innovation among students. This centre provides aspiring entrepreneurs with mentorship, resources, and networking opportunities to develop and launch their start-up ventures successfully. Various activities were organised to promote entrepreneurship among students successfully.

## Key Highlights (2024-25)

- (1.) **Industry Visit (April 26, 2025):** Eight female students visited the Incubation Centre at Govt. College, Panchkula, to explore turning artistic talents into business ideas. The visit empowered them with confidence and entrepreneurial skills.
- (2.) **Idea Kriti Program (June 25, 2024):** Six students attended a five-day workshop on start-ups, learning essential business skills such as market needs, business validation, and entrepreneurship qualities.
- (3.) **Expert Session on Start-ups (July 15, 2024):** A session by Tanushree from the Incubation Centre, Sec-1 Panchkula introduced students to start-up challenges, product development, pricing strategies, and market analysis.
- (4.) **Product Development & Market Analysis:** Five students presented product samples, receiving feedback on cost reduction, market competition, and teamwork for future business growth.
- (5.) **Crochet Weaving Workshop (August 31, 2024):** Female students learned crochet weaving as a skill-based activity. Experts discussed the historical significance of textiles and the importance of handicrafts in entrepreneurship.
- (6.) **Entrepreneurship Awareness Program:** A team from Govt. PG College, Panchkula, informed students about entrepreneurship, incubation support, and upcoming state-level competitions (Sept 16-20).
- (7.) **Idea Kriti 6.0:** Students participated in a start-up training program covering business planning, market fit, customer acquisition, and pitching ideas. Due to transport issues, part of the training was conducted online.
- (8.) **Inter-College Sanjhi & Terracotta Workshop (Sept 27, 2024):** A workshop was organized in collaboration with Silk Route NGO, Delhi,

where 62 students from multiple colleges learned traditional *Sanjhi* and *Terracotta* art forms.

- (9.) **Mehndi Celebration (Oct 19, 2024):** Organized by the Women's Cell and Incubation Centre, this event allowed 25 students to showcase their skills, and gain confidence in monetizing their artistic talents.

## College Library

Under the guidance of Dr. Aparna, college Library efficiently supports academic and research activities. With well-organized resources and smooth operations, the library plays a vital role in enhancing students' learning experiences and providing access to valuable study materials. Our college has an outstanding library streamlined through the implementation of Integrated Library Management Software (ILMS) SOUL 3.0. The library is equipped with more than 9,000 books in varied subjects like English, Hindi, Punjabi, Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics, Commerce, Computer Science, Political Science, Geography, History, Physical Education etc. It has a collection of both text and reference books. Library is fully air conditioned with the facility of inverter and comfortable furniture. The library



has membership of INFLIBNET, for facilitating the availability of unlimited number of journals in every branch of study. Annual subscription of N-List from INFLIBNET has also been renewed for 2024-25. N-List subscription makes college library rich in accessing e-resources (e-resources and e-books). The library has subscribed to three newspapers: The Indian Express, ( English) Ajit Samachar, (Hindi) and Amar Ujala. (Hindi) Additionally, all e-journals available through NLIST, INFLIBNET can be accessed, including Annual Reviews, Indian Journals, Institute of Physics, JSTOR, Oxford University Press, Cambridge University Press, Royal Society of Chemistry, EBSCO, and Indian and Political Weekly. College library has sitting capacity of more than 50 in reading room. Facility of reading room and digital lounge for teachers and students provide an academic amiable space to pursue their academic goals.



Under the supervision of Mr. Parveen and his dedicated team, the university cell efficiently manages examinations, internal assessments, exam Forms and other academic processes related to students. The cell ensures smooth coordination of university guidelines, timely execution of assessments, and proper record-keeping. A dedicated team has been formed to assist in administrative tasks,

enhancing efficiency and streamlining work. This committee is a great support system to the students throughout their academic journey.

### **Scholarships and Stipends**

#### **(1) Consolidated Stipend Scheme & Free Books Scheme for Scheduled Caste Students Perusing Higher Education**

*In the current session, under Consolidated Stipend Scheme and Free Books Scheme for SC Students. 58 SC students applied for this scholarship, an amount of Rs. 2000 for books and stipend of Rs.1000 per student for 12 months is given to such students.*

#### **(2.) Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Post-Matric Scholarship for OBC, EBC and DNT Students for studying in India**

*The objective of the scheme is to provide financial assistance to the OBC, EBC and DNT students studying at post-matriculation or post-secondary stage to enable them to complete their education. 15 applications have been received under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Post-Matric Scholarship for OBC.*

### **(3.) Haryana State Meritorious Incentive Scheme for the students who attain merit position in Annual University Examinations.**

*The objective of the scheme is to encourage the meritorious students studying in the Government Colleges of the State by giving a substantial amount to them as a motivating incentive. It has been instituted in order to encourage excellence in academics and overall development of the students. Under the scheme the male students (General Category) female students (General Category) and S.C. students (both male and female) will be given fixed annual incentive, based on their position/performance in Annual University examination of main educational streams, such as Arts, Commerce, Science (Medical and Non-Medical) and Education in both undergraduate and post graduate classes.*

- *This scheme will be college-specific and for three meritorious students in each stream who stood first, second and third in the annual university examination will be given this incentive.*
- *The incentive will be awarded separately for each stream i.e. Arts, Commerce, Science (Medical/Non-Medical) and Education. The students who stands first in the merit will be given Rs.5000/- p.a., second - Rs.3000/- p.a. and the student who stands third in the Merit will be given Rs.2000/- p.a.*

### **Beautification Committee**

Under the convenorship of Dr. Aparna, the college campus is well-maintained with the dedicated efforts of gardeners. Seasonal plants are regularly planted to enhance the greenery, and a Herbal Garden has been established, featuring local medicinal plants like Tulsi and Aleovera others. These initiatives not only beautify the campus but also promote environmental sustainability and ecological awareness among students.



## Sports

## NSS (National Service Scheme)

The NSS volunteers are doing community service under the Programme officers Dr. Raj (NSS PO of Boys Unit) and Dr Anju Dhull (NSS PO of Girls Unit). Two units of NSS are currently operational, one dedicated to girls and the other to boys. The volunteers have been trained to believe in the motto- 'Not me, But you'. ### Women Cell

Under the convenorship of Dr. Parveen, Assistant Prof in Chemistry, the Women Cell of the college organized various activities to achieve the goals of women empowerment.



Under the leadership of Dr Veenu Saini, The *Earn While You Learn* program has been instrumental in providing students with financial support while allowing them to gain practical experience in various departments. During the 2024-25 session, a total of Rs. 45,000 was distributed among students, with Rs. 32,700 benefiting 24 students in November 2024 and Rs. 12,300 supporting 20 students in December 2024. This initiative enabled students to work in multiple departments, including Chemistry, Computer, Physics, and Geography Labs, as well as the Happiness Center, Dispensary, Library, NSS (Boys & Girls), Gym, Placement Cell, Eco Club, Women's Cell, Sports, and the Bursar's Office. By



engaging in these roles, students not only received financial assistance but also developed essential skills and work experience, contributing to their overall personal and professional growth while ensuring the smooth functioning of institutional operations.

### **Mentorship**

Under the convenorship of Dr. Parveen, the Mentor Groups of the students are being guided not only through Mentor- Mentee meeting but also through WhatsApp, Regular counselling is provided to students who face any difficulty in any field to achieve their goals. Students feedback are taken also in these meetings. In the current session various mentor mentee meeting held to guide the students.

### **Placement Cell**

Under the convenorship of Dr. Ruby Mangla, the cell has been playing an active role in getting students prepared for jobs around them. Extension lectures were conducted during this session, on various significant topics, like: Job Opportunities, interview skills, and Career in Banking. Following activities were conducted during the session 2024-25

### **Placement Cell Activities (2024-25) – Key Highlights**

- **Enrollment:** 33 students from BA III, BCA III, B.COM III, and B.SC III enrolled in the Placement Cell.
- **Extension Lecture (28/08/2024):** Mr. Shekhar Jindal delivered a session on competitive exam preparation (**HPSC, UPSC, RRB, IBPS**) covering **Reasoning, GK, English, and Quantitative Aptitude**. Attended by 50 students.
- **Pre-Situation Visit (11/09/2024):** 30 students visited **HSIIDC, Barwala**, guided by **Ms. Rubi Mangala and Dr. Shubha**, gaining industry exposure.

- **Extension Lecture - “Campus to Corporate” (17/09/2024):** Ms. **Kalpana Gandhi** educated students on communication, teamwork, time management, and interview skills to ease their transition into corporate life. 50 students participated.
- **UPSC Workshop (20-21/11/2024):** Gyan Darpan IAS Academy, Panchkula conducted sessions on UPSC exam strategies, Mathematics, and Reasoning skills. 60 students attended this workshop.
- **Two days’ workshop organised on career prep dated 27 & 28-2-25** before Mega Job fair i.e. going to be held on 5-3-25. Fifty seven students attended this workshop Ms Benu Rao interacted with students and discussed main ideas regarding how to face interviews.

These initiatives equipped students with practical knowledge, career insights, and essential professional skills for future opportunities.

### Legal Literacy Cell

Under the convenorship of Dr. Namrata, our college actively engages in creating awareness on various social and legal issues.



Through seminars, workshops, and awareness campaigns, students are educated about their legal rights, including the Right to Education, Right to Equality, and Protection Against Harassment. 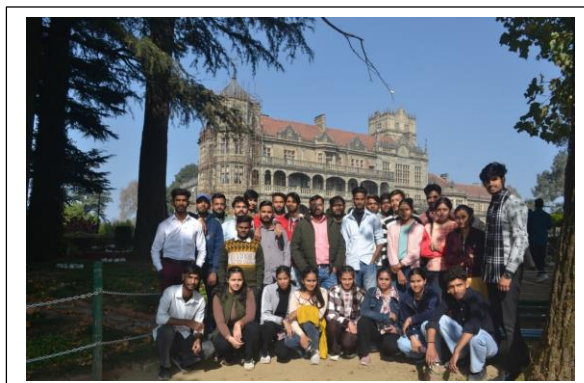
### Free Bus Pass Facility

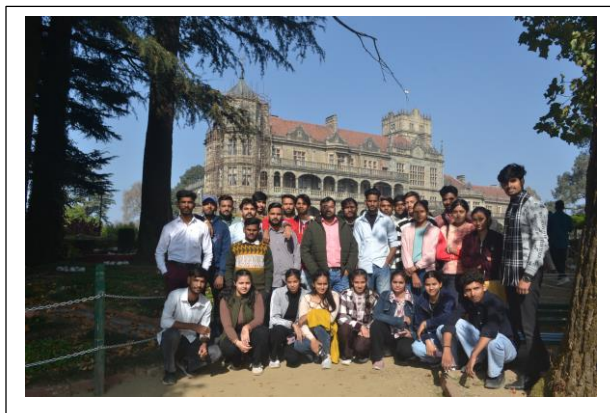

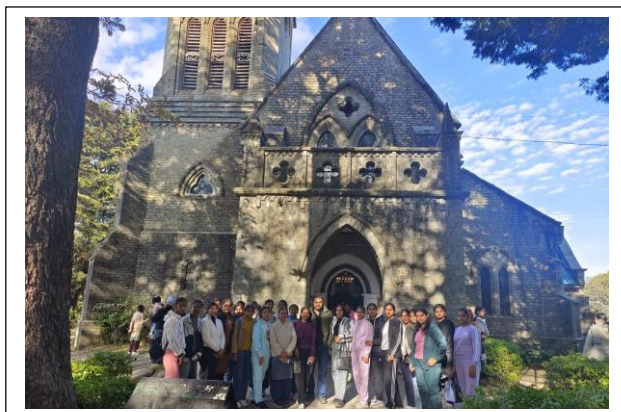

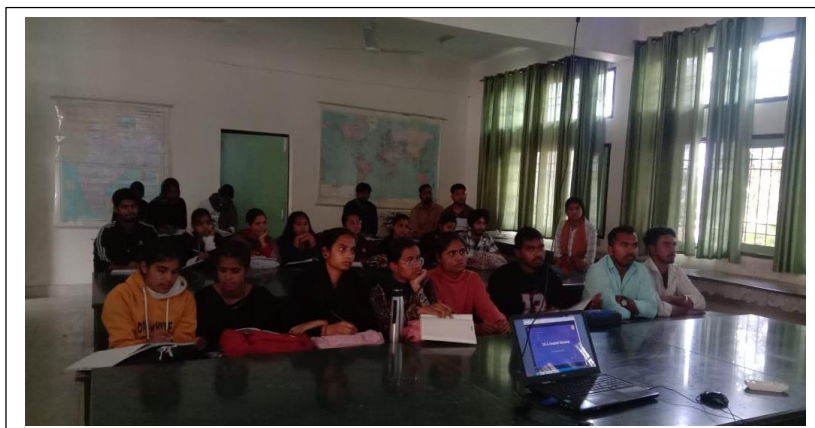
